I am having reoccurring problems with another website copying text from my website to use on theirs. In the recent past I have warned them to take copied material off of their site and they have. However, they keep copying other pages on from my site.

The website that copies mine is <http://thailandbirdwatching.com> I am the owner of <http://thailandbirding.com>

An example of what I mean is on <http://www.thailandbirdwatching.com/tarutao-island.htm> Much of the text on their page was taken directly from my webpage <http://paddleasia.com/destinations/tarutao.htm>

Their webpage:

"There is a park headquarters with bungalows where we stay. The long beach in front of the park adds much beauty to an already stunning scene. A tidal river next to the park is where we do our first destination of exploring. Usually, we could spend several days exploring on this area. We are kayaking in the mangrove forest beside. There are many birds in the mangrove forests. Brown-winged Kingfishers, large size, red bill and chocolate-brown wings, mantle and tail, rump turquoise are often seen. Some Flycatchers and Oriental Pied hornbills regularly cross over the mangrove channels or soaring along the side of the limestone mountains. Ashy Drongos, and Black Drongos medium-sized black color, flutter between trees in front of the park headquarters in their constant search for some insects."

My webpage:

"There is a park headquarters with bungalows where we land. The long beach in front of the park adds much beauty to an already stunning scene. A tidal river next to the park is where we do our first bit of exploring. Actually, you could spend several days exploring just this one area. We paddle in a mangrove forest beside steep limestone cliffs. There are lots of birds in the mangrove. Brown-winged Kingfishers, bright orange birds with brown wings and a blue back, are often seen. Oriental Pied hornbills and Southern Pied hornbills regularly cross over the mangrove channels or soar along the side of the massive limestone mountains. Greater Ratchet-tailed Drongos, medium-sized black birds with two very long tail feathers, flutter between trees at the park headquarters in their constant search for insects."
