**Re: Infringement Notification: <www.Page6blog.blogspot.com>**

To Whom It May Concern:

I am an attorney in the legal department of News America Incorporated (subsidiary of News Corporation), which acts as in-house legal counsel for NYP Holdings, Inc., publisher of the *New York Post* daily newspaper ("*Post*") and its online edition available located at [www.nypost.com](http://www.nypost.com) ("*Post Website*").

As you may be aware, since January 1977, the *Post* has published a daily gossip column entitled *Page Six* (the "Page Six Column"), which features celebrity news and gossip. The Page Six Column is an extremely popular, well-known feature of the *Post*. In addition to appearing in the *Post*, the Page Six Column is also available online and is accessible through the *Post Website*. NYP Holdings owns the rights in the Page Six Column, including the copyrights in the articles that appear therein and the famous PAGE SIX trademarks. Attached for your reference is a copy of the Page Six Column, which appeared in the July 7, 2005 edition of the *Post*.

It has recently come to our attention that someone has created a blog, hosted by Google's Blogger, at [www.Page6blog.blogspot.com](http://www.Page6blog.blogspot.com) (the "Blog"). Attached for your reference is a print out of the Blog, dated July 7, 2005. As you can see by accessing the archives of the Blog, the Blog reprints the copyrighted articles in the Page Six Column on a daily basis. In fact, the Blog purports to be a substitution for the Page Six Column as the upper-right hand caption reads: "PAGE6 WITHOUT HASSLE. NO REGISTRATION NO EMAILS. PLUS WHO REALLY READS THE POST FOR ANYTHING ELSE?"

Clearly, this copying and reproduction of NYP Holding's copyrighted material on the Blog is blatant theft and constitutes copyright infringement under U.S. law. See 17 U.S.C. § 106. Accordingly, we request that Google remove or disable access to the Blog.

In addition, we are unfortunately unable to discover the identity of or contact information for the person or entity responsible for the Blog. Accordingly, we would appreciate it if you could send us the contact information from Blogger's records so we can contact them directly. While we are aware of Google's privacy policy, disclosure of this contact information is necessary to protect the intellectual property rights of NYP Holdings.

I have a good faith belief that use of the copyrighted materials described above on the allegedly infringing Blog is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law. Further, I swear, under penalty of perjury, that the information in this notification is accurate and that I am authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner of an exclusive right that is infringed.

FORMER CBS producer **Mary Mapes**, whose mishandling of the National Guard memo story cost **Dan Rather** his anchor's chair, has turned to her famed former colleague for help on her upcoming tell-all.

"Dan is in constant contact with Mary," an insider tells PAGE SIX. "We are all in shock. I mean, she [bleeped] him and put him on the National Guard story, and now he calls her every day and helps her with the book!"

Mapes was fired from CBS in January after the flap over **President Bush's** National Guard records, which also led to Rather resigning from the "CBS Evening News" in March after 24 years in the anchor's chair.

The Emmy-winning producer got a hefty settlement from CBS to go away quietly and then got a six-figure sum from St. Martin's to write a tell-all, "The Other Side of the Story," due out in November.

"Mary has been sending Dan chapters of her book for him to read through," says our source.

"He is helping her. I don't know if he is editing parts of it, but he is giving her information and comments."

Rather, who is still on staff with CBS, is "trying to make sure he comes out all right and is trying to help salvage his name through Mary's book," the outraged insider says. Rather is said to be furious with his new, marginalized position at "60 Minutes."

"Dan has got nothing to do," the source elaborates. "No one at '60 Minutes' wants him doing pieces for them because he's considered tainted. Everyone at CBS just wants him to leave the building but he won't. He's bored and Mary strokes his ego telling him, 'You're so great, Dan. You're still the best. Dan.' But still, no one can believe

paycheck."

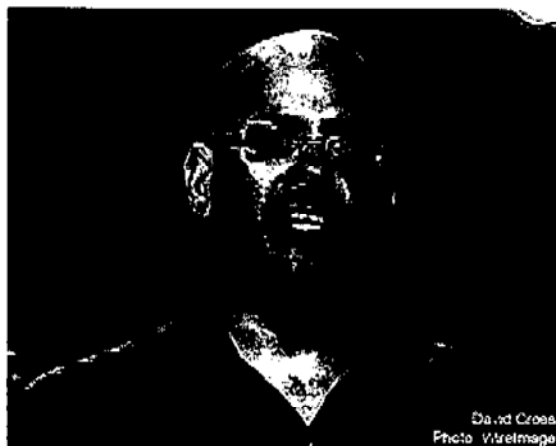
Another CBS employee said Rather is a pariah in the building: "I cross the street when I see him, if you know what I mean."

If Mapes' book is anything like her proposal, it will be devastating for the network and its head, **Les Moonves**.

In her book proposal, Mapes sniped about Moonves' marriage to CBS "Early Show" co-host **Julie Chen**, writing, "Moonves demonstrated what has been joked about for years: that everything he knows about journalism has been sexually transmitted."

Mapes also gushed about "Dan's constant loyalty and phone calls when I was at my lowest points." A rep for CBS and Rather declined comment.

**FUNNYMAN David Cross** is getting into the nightclub business. The "Arrested Development" star is buying into Eleven, on Orchard Street, with Strokes guitarist **Albert Hammond Jr.** and two other pals. Cross' girlfriend,
