I am a member of a Dutch music group called the Rotterdam Ska-Jazz Foundation. We expose ourselves via <http://www.rsjf.nl> of which I am the owner. I hereby like to file the following notice of infringement.

1. The copyrighted work at issue mainly concerns the meta content text that appears in the index.html file of our website <http://www.rsjf.nl>. A sample of what one finds when searching Google with the search string "Rotterdam ska jazz foundation" is (August 7, 2006.)

As can be clearly observed, the meta content description is almost plain copied (it was plain copied but we changed ours a little recently). The owner of the domain uses the address <http://www.rsjfoundation.com> first to expose an act of slander about the Rotterdam Ska-Jazz Foundation, and then redirects visitors to the domain <http://www.ollieq.com>

What appears to be the biggest question is how <http://www.rsjfoundation.com> can be on top in Google while there is nearly any other side referring to it. This must be an act of illegal use of Google. Please immediately remove or disable all access to the infringing material.
